

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

## 13<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Construction Update

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing construction on the I-43/94 northbound bridge over 13<sup>th</sup> Street.

The week of July 5<sup>th</sup>, bridge girders will be set during nighttime hours. This work will create noise and dust. Additional lighting will be brought on-site and the contractor will be utilizing dust control measures. Motorists should be aware

of changing traffic patterns on 13<sup>th</sup> Street during nighttime hours to safely accommodate this overhead work.
