

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction will begin in 2009 and end in 2016.

As part of the I-94 North-South freeway project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing the County G interchange and frontage roads and I-94 mainline at County G beginning in 2009.

- Northbound entrance/exit closed June `09 - September `10
- Southbound entrance/exit ramps closed August `09 - December `09

County G Frontage Roads

Spring `09 - Fall `09

- East frontage road closed June `09 - July `09
- West frontage road closed August `09 - September `09
