

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

20th Street Bridge Scheduled to Reopen

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is nearing completion of the new 20th Street bridge over I-894, as part of the I-94 North-South Freeway Project.

The 20th Street bridge over I-894 is scheduled to reopen to both vehicles and pedestrians on Saturday, December 10th, 2011.

Please note: the last day of MPS shuttle service to/from Lowell Elementary School around the bridge closure will be *Friday, December 9th, 2011.*

Motorists should be aware that construction crews will still be present completing minor work in the area, such as pavement work in the medians, after the bridge is reopened.
