- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

## 27<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project August Update

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing to resurface 27<sup>th</sup> Street from College Avenue to Howard Avenue. In addition to pavement repairs and a new driving surface, WisDOT is constructing safety improvements at signalized intersections and medians, and installing Community Sensitive Design features.

Stage 2 of the resurfacing project is scheduled to begin as early as Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup> from Howard Avenue to I-894. During Stage 2, construction crews will be working in the right lane of 27<sup>th</sup> Street in both directions from Howard Avenue to I-894. The middle, left and left turn lane remain open during daytime hours.

Stage 2 from I-894 south to College Avenue is scheduled to occur in early September. The 27<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project is scheduled to be complete by November, 2010.
