## ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

## 27<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project Update

In Spring 2010, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be resurfacing 27<sup>th</sup> Street from College Avenue to Howard Avenue. In addition to pavement repairs and a new driving surface, WisDOT will be constructing safety improvements at signalized intersections and medians, and installing Community Sensitive Design features.

Stage 1 of the resurfacing project is scheduled to begin as early as the week of May 10, 2010. During Stage 1, construction crews will be working in the medians and the inside lane of 27<sup>th</sup> Street. Two lanes will remain open in each direction during daytime hours.

The 27<sup>th</sup> Street Resurfacing Project is scheduled to be complete by November, 2010.

WisDOT is committed to coordinating with businesses in the 27<sup>th</sup> Street work zone.

**A follow-up business meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, May 11 at 8 a.m. at the project field office, 5675 S. 27<sup>th</sup> St.** Project staff will be available to discuss contractor work plans and schedule and address any specific business concerns.
