ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

Howard Avenue Resurfacing Project Update

In late summer 2010, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is resurfacing Howard Avenue from 13th Street to 6th Street, and making intersection improvements at the I-94/43 northbound and southbound exits with Howard Avenue. This work will prepare the roadway for anticipated traffic during the 2011-2012 Mitchell Interchange reconstruction.



Beginning the week of August 16th, single lane closures will occur in both directions on Howard Avenue from 13th Street to 6th Street. Motorists should note that the Holt Avenue project is scheduled to be complete prior to the start of work on Howard Avenue, and Holt Avenue will be available as an alternate route.

The Howard Avenue Resurfacing Project is scheduled to be complete in Fall 2010. The project team appreciates your patience and cooperation during this project.
