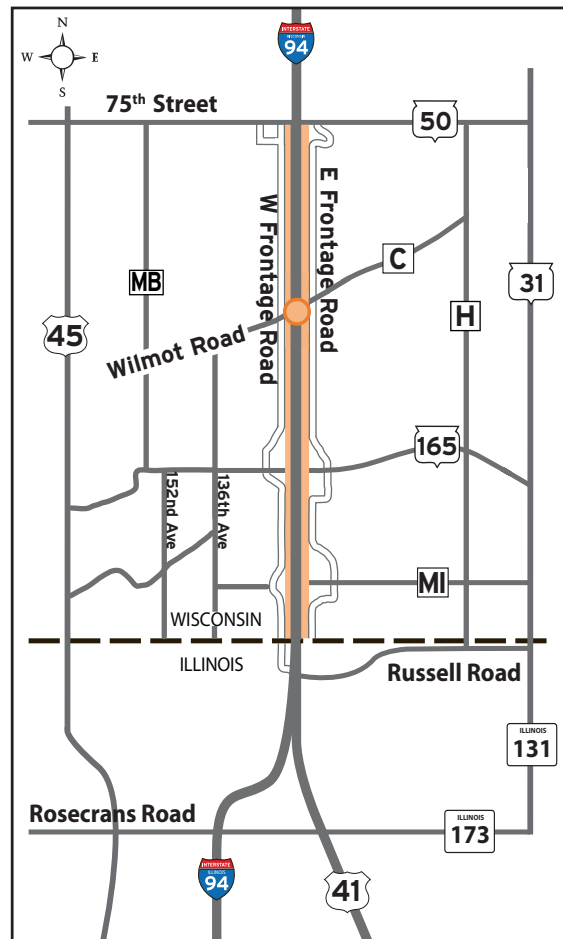
I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will end in 2016.

I-94 mainline construction in Kenosha Co.

As part of the I-94 North-South freeway project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing the I-94 mainline freeway from the Illinois state line to the Des Plaines River (just south of WIS 50) beginning in 2009.



I-94 Mainline from the Illinois state line to the Des Plaines River

- Southbound mainline reconstruction Mid July `09 - December `09
- Northbound mainline reconstruction April `10 - November `10
- Two lanes open in both directions June `09 - December `10

Scheduled Closures*

- One lane on I-94 West (northbound) from Russell Road to just south of WIS 50 June 9 `09 - December `09
- East (southbound) entrance and exit ramps at WIS 165 June 15 - late July `09
- One lane on I-94 East (southbound) from just south of WIS 50 to Russell Road from late June `09 - December `09
- CTH C entrance and exit ramps Mid July `09 to December `09

**All roadways and ramps are subject to temporary overnight closures. All closures are weather-dependent and subject to change.*

Alternate Routes

Southbound mainline traffic options

- exit WIS 50 east to WIS 31 south
- exit WIS 50 west to USH 45 south
- exit WIS 50 and take frontage roads south

Northbound mainline traffic options

- exit IL 173 west to USH 45 north
- exit IL 173 east to IL 131 north
- exit Russell Road west and take frontage roads north

WIS 165 ramp closure traffic options

- use County C interchange and frontage roads
