

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

Layton Avenue construction begins

As part of the I-94 North-South Freeway Project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing the Layton Avenue bridge over I-94, entrance and exit ramps, and roadway from 13th Street to 20th Street.

Work in the area will begin the week of February 14. As early as Wednesday, February 17, the bridge over I-94, entrance/exit ramps, and Layton Avenue roadway will be closed through fall 2010. The northbound entrance ramp to I-94 and southbound exit ramp to Layton Avenue will remain closed until fall 2012.

Demolition of the Layton Avenue bridge is scheduled for the week of February 21. For safety reasons, this demolition work will require full-freeway closures during nighttime hours. This work will create noise, dust, and some vibrations. Additional lighting will be brought on-site and the contractor will utilize dust control measures. All scheduled closures are weather-dependent and subject to change.

During the closures at Layton Avenue, motorists are encouraged to use College Avenue or Howard Avenue with 27th Street or Howell Avenue. Pedestrians needing access around the Layton Avenue bridge closure are encouraged to use the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) Route 55 service. No fare is required for those boarding the bus between S. 6th Street and S. 27th Street on Layton Avenue. Although, if the passenger wants to transfer to a different bus, they will need to pay full fare. For the latest information on MCTS routes and schedules, visit www.ridemcts.org.
