I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

Layton Ave. Resurfacing Project Update

In Spring 2010, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be making pavement repairs and resurfacing Layton Avenue (County Y) from Loomis Road to 27th Street.

Stage 1 of the project is scheduled to begin in mid-May. During Stage 1, construction crews will be working in the outside lane and parking lane of Layton Avenue. One lane will remain open in each direction at all times. This project is scheduled to be complete by late July, 2010.

As a reminder, the Layton Avenue Interchange remains under construction as part of the I-94 North-South Freeway Project, with Layton Avenue closed to traffic from 13th Street to 20th Street until Fall 2010.
