I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

Lowell Elementary School Shuttle Bus Info

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing reconstruction of the I-94 North-South Freeway, including the Mitchell Interchange. As part of this work, WisDOT is rebuilding the 20th Street bridge over I-894.

As early as the evening of December 22, 2010, 20th Street from Layton Avenue to Van Norman Avenue will be closed to traffic. Motorists should use 27th Street as an alternate route during this time. The 20th Street bridge is scheduled to reopen in late 2011.

MPS will be providing a shuttle bus to transport students to/ from Lowell Elementary School to the other side of the bridge via Layton Avenue, 27th Street, and Bolivar Avenue. Shuttle stops will be clearly marked with "LOWELL SHUTTLE STOP" signs. Students should wait on paved areas for the shuttle, which will pick-up on the south end at approximately 7:30 a.m. and on the north end at approximately 2:25 p.m.
