Oakwood Rd. Berm Construction Update - Fall 2011

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing reconstruction of the I-94 North-South Freeway in fall 2011.

Near Oakwood Road, installation of an earth berm began with preliminary work in fall 2010, and continued with the majority of berm construction in spring 2011. Recently the easternmost, inner earth berm near Oakwood Road was completed.

In fall 2011, additional landscaping is scheduled to be installed on the newly-constructed inner berm. This landscaping will provide additional screening from the freeway. In 2012, the berm is scheduled to be extended to Oakwood Road as part of interchange construction at Drexel Avenue.

The remainder of berm construction at Oakwood Road, including installation of the westernmost, outer portion of the berm, is scheduled to be constructed as part of the Elm Road Interchange. The Elm Road Interchange is scheduled to be constructed beginning in 2018, with outer berm construction scheduled to be complete in 2019. WisDOT is committed to constructing the outer berm in the area near Oakwood Road, however, construction schedules are subject to change due to funding availability.
