I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2016.

WIS 142 West & Frontage Road Construction Update

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing construction on the I-94 North-South Freeway Project. In Kenosha County in 2010, WisDOT will reconstruct the WIS 142 roadway west of I-94 and the WIS 142 west frontage road.

The following closures will be in effect:

- *Full closure of the West Frontage Road from WIS 142 to County E from the week of May 10, 2010 - late July 2010*
- *Full closure of WIS 142 west of the I-94 EAST (SB) ramps from the week of May 10, 2010 - late July 2010 (Traffic will be detoured to use County MB and County N to the East Frontage Road.)*
- *Full closure of WIS 142 West Frontage Road from WIS 142 to WIS 158 from late July - Fall 2010*

Available alternate routes during the construction at WIS 142 are the East Frontage Road and County E or WIS 158 interchanges.

Access to local businesses will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. Construction is scheduled to be complete in Fall 2010.
