

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction will begin in 2009 and be complete in 2016.

Whitaker Avenue Construction Update

As part of the I-94 North-South freeway project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing construction in the Mitchell Interchange area.

As early as April 8, contractors will close Whitaker Avenue to accommodate retaining wall and bridge construction in the area. Whitaker Avenue from 14th Street to 15th Street will be closed. Traffic can use Van Norman Avenue to access 14th Street and 15th Street.

Residents may experience an increase in noise and night construction activity during this time. This work is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2010.
